## THE GOSPEL

Read the following verses:

Galatians 1:1-9

### EXAMINING THE TEXT

1. Paul introduces himself in the book of Galatians in a particular way (Gal. 1:1). It is said that this is because his apostleship was being challenged. Based upon the way Paul defends his apostleship, what allegations may have been made to undermine his apostolic authority?
2. What motivated Paul to write this letter to the Galatians?

### DIGGING DEEPER

1. At the beginning of Galatians, Paul mentions the Gospel four times. So, what is the Gospel? What does it include and how complete is it?
2. When Paul says that the Galatians are "turning to a different gospel" (1:6), is he suggesting that a believer can lose their salvation or not?

### THE HEART OF THE MATTER

1. Today there are many "different gospels" presented by many different people. Which of these "gospels" have affected you negatively? Does your view of the real Gospel need to be adjusted?
