EXAMINING THE TEXT

Read the following verses:

Galatians 1:10-24

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Why did Paul's experience with God cause him to resist imposing the Sabbath, the Jewish dietary restrictions, circumcision, the Jewish feasts, the Temple in Jerusalem, and the sacrifices (i.e. the traditions of the fathers) on Gentile believers?

THE HEART OF THE MATTER

1. Paul went through a traumatic experience on the road to Damascus. It caused him to re-think his understanding of God and what God was doing. Paul even went away to Arabia (Gal. 1:17) perhaps to reconsider all things. Have you gone through some traumatic experience that has caused you to re-think?
2. The turning point for Paul's life was "But when He..." (Gal. 1:15). All Christians have this salvation experience. Spend some time telling one another brief accounts of your turning point with God.
