### EXAMINING THE TEXT

Read the following verses:

Galatians 2:1-10

1. What was the issue raised because Paul brought Titus along to Jerusalem?
2. According to Paul what were the issues at stake?

### DIGGING DEEPER

1. What might have been the line of reasoning behind those who opposed Paul and Barnabas?
2. What were the positive outcomes from Paul's point of view, from the visit to Jerusalem?

### THE HEART OF THE MATTER

1. What situation have you faced where you needed to be immovable concerning your Christian faith? What compromise were people expecting you to make?
2. The "false brothers" in Jerusalem were trying to impose "Jesus plus circumcision" on a (Gentile) new believer (Titus) in order for him to be fully accepted among God's people. Do we have a tendency to impose "Jesus plus (something)" upon believers who are new among us, before they're fully accepted by us? What are the "something's" which we add to "Jesus" in the equation—"Jesus plus (something)"?
