KNOW WHAT YOU BELIEVE

God's Creation

Familiarize yourselves with what is happening in these passages

Gen. 1:1-2:3; Ac. 17:24-26; Rom. 1:19-20;
Psa. 19:1-4; Heb. 1:10-12

EXAMINING THE TEXT

1. From the verses in Acts 17, what are the different aspects of God as Creator? What do these verses tell us about the origin of the human race with all their different ethnic groups?
2. What does Hebrews 1:10-12 tell us about God's relationship to His creation?
3. What things do Romans 1:19-20 and Acts 14:17 reveal about God as Creator?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. What are the essential (non-negotiable) items of the creation and what are the non-essential (negotiable) items of the creation?
2. Go through the section "What The Creation Reveals About God" and read at least one verse attached to each of the 10 points. Then in your own words speak to those in your group what the verse is showing us about God.
3. What are the logical implications of Atheistic evolution concerning God, God's purpose, destiny, standards of morality and ethics, good and evil, charity, benevolence, unselfish acts, climbing the corporate ladder, lying and cheating to get ahead, ethnic cleansing, etc.?

THE HEART OF THE MATTER

1. Knowing that God is the Creator of everything, ourselves included, what is the proper response and improper response to Him (Rom. 1:19-25)? Are you finding your responses to be consistent? Explain.
