

# **Jesus Is...**

## *Lord of the Possible & Impossible*

Read the following verses: John 6:1-21

### **Examining the Text:**

1. What is the need presented in John 6:1-13? What are the resources available? How is the impossibility described?
2. What is Jesus' miraculous solution?
3. What is the people's realization about Jesus?
4. Think about who the disciples are. Do you think the storm on the sea is a new experience for them? Would they feel capable of handling the storm?

### **Digging Deeper:**

1. What would or should Jesus' answer to the disciples in verse 20 mean to them (see Exodus 3:14)?

### **The Heart of the Matter:**

1. Talk among yourselves about situations you have faced that were impossible and you needed Jesus' help.
2. Think about areas of your life that you feel quite capable of taking care of by yourself (like the disciples on the Sea of Galilee). Where is Jesus in all of your confidence? Is there room for His help? Does Jesus want to help you?
3. In difficult areas of your life, how could Jesus help you: prayer, talking it through with the Lord, talking things through with an experienced believer, counseling?
