

Jesus Is...

The Bread of Life

Read the following verses: John 6:22-59

Examining the Text:

1. Jesus speaks about physical bread in John 6:26. He uses that bread to bring in the idea of another bread. List the different ways that Jesus describes the other bread.
2. What is the response that Jesus calls for from His listeners? There are many different ways that He says it, but what is the over-riding thought in all of them?
3. Believing is not a one-time thing. It is a continual and on-going thing (6:29). What does this imply about our Christian lives?
4. What does John 6:40 say the will of God is for each person?

Digging Deeper:

1. What does working for food that perishes mean?
2. What does working for food that leads to eternal life mean?

The Heart of the Matter:

1. You may know someone who has “fallen away” from Jesus (i.e. they are not following Him closely at this moment, or feel Jesus was good for them while they were younger). Read John 6:37 & 39. Does Jesus ever give up on people?
2. Have you given up on certain people? How do verses 37 & 39 help you?
