Read the following verses: John 6:41-71

Examining the Text:

1. The Jews objected to what Jesus claimed about Himself. How did they object (vv. 41-42)?
2. How did Jesus answer the Jews' objection in John 6:41-42?
3. What is the difference between Simon Peter (vv. 68-69) and the many disciples who turned away from Jesus (vv. 60 & 66)?

Digging Deeper:

1. How would you reconcile Jesus' statements:
 - "eat my flesh" (vv. 51-56)
 - "the flesh is no help at all" (v. 63)

The Heart of the Matter:

1. The Greek tense used in John 6:69 tells us that Peter actually said:
"We have come to believe and continue to believe, and have come to know and continue to know that You are the Holy One of God."
What is your experience of Peter's declaration? And, what helps you to experience this continual believing more?
