Finding Joy in Fellowship

Read the following verses: Philippians 1:12-14, 19-30

Examining the Text:

1. Paul identified (1:19) two things that would help him in his situation. What are they?
2. What was Paul's expectation and hope in 1:20?
3. Read Philippians 1:20b-26 again. Paul was considering two possible outcomes going forward. What were the benefits of each of the possible outcomes?

Digging Deeper:

1. How does Paul describe a life that is worthy of the Gospel (1:27-30)?

The Heart of the Matter:

1. Paul had his situation (1:12) which he described as "this" (1:19). He expected that God would advance the Gospel and his salvation. What is your "this"? How could your situation advance the Gospel (magnify Christ) and deepen your salvation experience?
