## **Sermon Summary:**

Peace Comes to a Troubled World

The story of Jesus birth in Luke concludes with the declaration of Peace on earth. The source of peace is the Prince of Peace (Isa. 9:6) that is Christ who is our peace (Eph. 2:14). To have peace means to have Christ. Jesus was the gift given by God to bring peace to humankind. To receive peace means to have a right relationship with God, a right relationship with others and then we will have peace with ourselves and our environment.

The current pandemic is troubling to most of us in some way or others. This is a time to have a deeper relationship with the Lord and not look to other things for our source of peace.

## Discussion:

- 1. Read Luke 2:14. Heaven and earth are mentioned in this verse. How does the birth of Jesus affect heaven and earth.
- 2. How are our relationships with others and with God intertwined?
- 3. If we are generally not at peace, what might this indicate?

- 4. The blessings of Numbers 6:24-26 are very comforting. What are ways that these verses can be used to strengthen and encourage you?
- 5. Conclude with speaking Numbers 6:24-26 to each other.

## End with Prayer.

- Pray for a deeper relationship with the Lord that brings the real peace.
- Pray for any needs of people in your group.
