## **Examining the text & our hearts:**

Bible Reading: Eph. 1:3-10

- I. God Has A Mission (Eph. 1:9-10)
  - "The goal of [God's mission] is to incorporate people into the Kingdom of God & to involve them in his mission." –Arthur Glasser
- II. Seeing Who You Are In Yourself: Disqualified (Eph. 1:4-10)
- A. In yourself you are not holy (1:4)
- B. In yourself you are not blameless (1:4)
- C. In yourself you are full of sinful thoughts, words & deeds (1:7)
- D. In yourself you are blind to what God is doing (1:9)
- III. Seeing Who You Are In Christ: Qualified (Eph. 1:3-10)
- A. God's mission has reached you
  - "Ephesians narrates the triune God's [Mission]; it invites the Church to participate in God's mission by becoming what they were called to be." –I. Ninan
- B. You are blessed with 'every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, in Christ' (1:3)
  - 1. 'Spiritual blessings" (Eph. 1:3b)
  - "Spiritual here refers above all to the Holy Spirit through whom the blessings...come to us."—P.
  - S. Williamson
  - 2. "in the heavenly places," (Eph. 1:3c) not "in heaven in eternity"

- a. Some (wrongly) postpone these blessings to eternity future in 'heaven,' after resurrection
- b. 'heavenly blessings' available here & now for our experience
- "God...is already on a mission...God...is seeking not just to save 'souls' to heaven some day, but to save & restore the created order: individuals, communities...the world, the cosmos."—Michael Gorman
- "In the heavenly places'...suggests, not that believers are...transported to heaven & out of...this world...but rather that by being in Christ they share in [God's] powerful grace...
  Believers therefore lead their lives on earth, in the present, in light of heavenly...realities..." Michael Gorman
- 3. 'in Christ" (1:3d)
- "To be 'in Christ' is to...be caught up in God's mission & thus in God's character—indeed God's very life...[It is] participation in the life & mission of God." -Michael Gorman
- C. God's blessings determine our identity
  - "Eph. 1:3-14 functions to form the identity of the people of God, shap[ed by] what God has done & how they play a central role in the work of God to recapture and redeem the world." –Tim Gombis
- D. You are chosen to be holy & blameless (1:4)
- E. You are a child of God (1:5)
- F. You are forgiven & released from all your sins/trespasses (1:7; 1 Cor. 15:3)
  - "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses..." (Eph. 1:7)
- G. You are qualified to join God in his mission (1:9-10)
  - "The language of election & adoption is not an idiom of individual or even corporate predestination over against the non-elect...It is the language of corporate identity, answering the questions, 'Who are we?'"—Michael Gorman

## IV. You Are Chosen For God's Mission

- A. Like Abraham was chosen (Gen. 12:1-3)
  - 1. There was nothing special about him (Josh. 24:2)
  - 2. Chosen to bless others
- B. Choosing means privilege & responsibility (Gen. 12:3b)
- **V. Respond By Blessing God** (Eph. 1:3, 6, 12, 14)
  - "When people bless God, they praise him. When God blesses [us], he confers a benefit."—Peter Williamson
