- A. The Legal (forensic) Aspect
- B. Justification in Gal. 2: not 'alien righteousness transferred,' but union with the righteous One
- C. Justification in Gal. 2—Relational, participation

Justification in Galatians 2

A. What is justification?

- 1. Approval/ acceptance by God
- 2. Not based on works of law (Torah)
- 3. Based on faith in Christ
- B. Paul and Peter's experience "we" 2:16
 - "We know that a person is not justified by the works of the law [Torah]
 - 1. The works of law do not refer to general good works
 - 2. "We know a person is justified by faith in Jesus Christ" v. 16a
 - 1. We believed in Christ Jesus
 - 2. So we are justified by faith in Christ
 - 3. Not by works of the law
 - 4. No one is justified by works of law
 - 5. Implies that the law did not justify
 - For Peter to separate from Gentiles was to step back to pre-salvation in Christ, to before he trusted in Christ
- C. Jewish believers have had a change of status
 - 1. From being accepted based on keeping the law [Torah] to being accepted because of faith and trust in Christ
 - 2. Gentile believers also accepted in Christ
 - 3. Now both Jewish and Gentile believers have a new and equal status.
 - 4. Both are righteous (justified, accepted, approved) by believing and trusting in Christ
- D. Based on this new status we can and must have common table fellowship with all believers

What is faith in Jesus Christ?

- A. Not merely mental assent
- B. A relationship of trust
- C. A response to the faithfulness of Christ
- D. It is based on the faithfulness of Jesus to the Father's will.
