The Old Covenant Replaced by the New (Jer. 31:31-34; Ezek. 36:26-27; Gal. 3:24a, 25)

Justified: Made Right with God Through Christ (Gal. 2:16)

- A. Heritage is not able to make us right with God
- B. Only abandoning all & trusting in Christ is sufficient
- C. We enter a relationship with God

'Seeking' to be Justified in Christ (Gal. 2:17)

- A. The new life of a Christ-follower: *'seeking to be justified'*
- B. Colliding with the law (our heritage)
- C. Christ is not leading us into sin

Living in Open Defiance of God (Gal. 2:18)

- A. Insisting on things that divide or separate Christians
- B. Rejecting & nullifying God's work

Living to God (Gal. 2:19)

- A. Dead to the law because of our union with the death of Christ
- B. Living to God
 - 1. Maturely acknowledge that God can lead people in different ways
 - 2. Cultivate your relationship with God through spiritual practices
