Bible Reading: 1 John 3:11-24

The Context of the Letter & the Condition of the Believers

Learning to Love Again (1 Jn. 3:1, 11-18)

A. Love one another: The message we heard from the beginning (v. 11)

- 1. Don't follow Cain's example (v. 12) the counterexample to loving one another
- 2. Don't be surprised when the world hates you (v. 13)
- 3. Loving one another proves you have passed out of death & into life (vv. 14-15)
- B. Love one another as Jesus loved us (vv. 16-17)
 - 1. He laid down his life for us
 - 2. We should lay down our lives for others
 - 3. If we have material means, we should help others in need
- C. Love one another in action & truth, not just word or speech (v. 18)

We Should Trust God (1 Jn. 3:19-24)

A. Whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our hearts (vv. 19-20)

- 1. Whenever our heart condemns us
- 2. God is greater than our hearts
- B. If our hearts don't condemn us, (vv. 21-22)
 - 1. We have confidence before God
 - 2. We receive whatever we ask from God because
 - 1. We keep his commands
 - 2. We do what is pleasing in his sight

- 3. God's Command (vv. 23-24a)
 - 1. Believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ
 - 2. Love one another
 - 3. The key to mutually remaining in one another
- 4. Reassured by the Spirit that we remain in God (v. 24b)
