"Do You Love Me?" - Jesus

Jesus Restores Peter (21:15-19)

- A. Peter's previous failure
 - 1. Boasted that he'd never abandon Jesus (Matt. 26:31, 33; Jn. 13:37-38)
 - 2. Denied Jesus three times (Jn. 18:15-18, 25-27)
- B. The three-fold question & answer (vv. 15-17)
 - 1. Jesus questions Peter three times (vv. 15a, 16a, 17a)
 - 1. "Do you love me?" (v. 15a, 16a, 17a)
 - 2. "More than these?" (v. 15a)
 - 3. Is this John's Greek rendering of a conversation conducted in Aramaic?
 - 2. Peter's answer (vv. 15b, 16b, 17b)
 - 1. "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." (vv. 15b, 16b)
 - 2. "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." (v. 17b)

Jesus Re-Commissions Peter (vv. 15c, 16c, 17c)

- A. Restoration deals with the past
- B. Re-commissioning deals with the future
- C. "Feed my lambs." (v. 15c)
- D. "Shepherd my sheep." (v. 16c)
- E. "Feed my sheep." (v. 17c)
- F. Not as 'the' shepherd of the flock
- G. Jesus' charge to 'shepherd', is conditioned by 'Do you love me?'
- H. "Shepherd my (Jesus') sheep" the 'sheep' remain Jesus' 'sheep'
- I. 'Shepherd' does not imply ruling

- J. Loving Jesus has a practical side
- K. Jesus tells Peter his discipleship will end in martyrdom (vv. 18-19a)
- L. Martyrdom
- M. Peter & Jesus' deaths linked
- N. Following Jesus means suffering of some kind
- O. "Follow me"
- P. Peter's discipleship took the form of feeding & shepherding
- Q. Peter's desire to die for Jesus was now possible (v. 19b)

The Beloved Disciple Will Bear Witness to Jesus (Jn. 21:20-24)

- A. The beloved disciple followed Peter & Jesus (v. 20)
- B. Peter asked Jesus, "Lord, what about him?" (v. 21)
- C. Jesus adjusts Peter (v. 22)
 - 1. "If I want him to remain until I come, what is that to you?"
 - 2. "As for you, follow me."
- D. John corrects a rumor (v. 23)
- E. John bears witness to Jesus in all that he wrote (v. 24)

Love Without Limits – Words of Love Must Be Matched by a Life of Love

- A. The gift of our physical lives for others
- B. Love others as you are called by Jesus
- C. "You, follow me."
